In2Surrey Scheme

Interested in studying at University of Surrey but not sure you'll get the grades?



You might qualify for a one grade reduced offer if you participate in the In2Surrey scheme as well as a scholarship. Find out more here



Students who successfully complete the K+programme are eligible for the reduced offer to study at King's College worth up to two A-level grades lower than the standard offer (excluding medicine and dentistry).

Alongside this, all students who successfully complete the K+ programme will receive the K+ start up bursary of up to £1000 in their first year of university. More info **here**.
