STUDY PROGRAMME

If you are between 16 and 18 years old, you will join a Study Programme at Coulsdon College. The programme will combine classroom study, English and maths, personal study, work experience and other activities to enrich your learning.

English and maths retakes are available, and can be studied alongside your main programme.

A LEVELS

We offer 26 A Level courses. You can study a number of different subject areas. These will give you the academic standing needed for university, Higher Education, employment or a higher-level apprenticeship.

BTECS

We offer 18 BTEC courses to choose from. Either standalone qualifications, or part of a mix and match programme with A Levels. BTECs are industry-focused qualifications that combine practical and theoretical studies. BTECs are recognised by universities and employers alike as suitable entry qualifications for university courses, apprenticeships and graduate training programmes.

MIX AND MATCH

PATHWAYS

Depending on your mix of subjects, students are assigned to one of the four pathways – usually this is where most of their study time takes place. The pathway structure enables us to provide every student with a bespoke package based on their needs.

T-LEVELS

T Levels are two-year qualifications for 16-19-year-olds. They are equivalent to A Levels and Level 3 qualifications, combining classroom theory, practical learning and substantial industry placements to make sure students have real experience of the workplace.

We're excited to offer a T Level in Laboratory Science, taught in a brand new bespoke laboratory. T Levels offer students a mixture of classroom learning and 'on-the-job' experience during an industry placement of at least 315 hours (approximately 45 days).

Unlike many school sixth forms, students at Coulsdon Sixth Form College have the option to 'mix and match' A Levels with BTEC Level 3 courses, alternatively you can opt to study all A Levels or all BTECs. The 'mix and match' combinations are virtually endless. This ensures your timetable is tailor-made for you, giving you the best possible chance of doing well. If you don't achieve English Language or Maths GCSE at grade 4 or above, you will also continue to study these subjects.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

To study a standard A Level programme (three A Levels) you must have a minimum of five GCSEs grade 4 and above including English and maths. You must also meet the specific subject entry requirements. For a mixed programme of A Levels and BTEC Level 3 courses you must have five GCSEs grade 4 and above which could include one BTEC and either GCSE English or maths as appropriate for your chosen courses.

A LEVEL BUSINESS

A LEVEL | Two Years

COURSE OVERVIEW

This course encourages the practical application of business concepts by exploring events in the business world and relating these to theories and practice. You will cover topics such as entrepreneurship, starting a business, marketing and human resources. You will also look at the wider influences on businesses through strategic planning, finance and the economy.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

At least five GCSE passes, at grade 4 or above. This includes a grade 5 in English Language and grade 6 in maths.

BTEC LEVEL 2 | One Year

COURSE OVERVIEW

This course equips you with a wide range of knowledge, skills, and behaviours to prepare you for a Level 3 Business programme or an Apprenticeship. You will study topics such as enterprise in the business world, finance for business, marketing and customer service. You will also take part in work experience and business visits, as well as initiatives such as interview preparation and role plays.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

At least three Level 2 and two Level 3 at GCSE including English and Mathematics minimum grade 2 or equivalent qualifications (a Pass or higher at BTEC Level 2 is accepted as part of the GCSE grades).

COURSE OVERVIEW

This course is ideal if you have an interest in business and leadership, if you enjoy working with people, or if you would like to develop an activity or passion you already have by setting up a business. At least four GCSE passes at grade 4 or above. Additionally for Business, English minimum grade 4 and maths minimum grade 4 or equivalent qualifications.

A LEVEL COMPUTER SCIENCE

A LEVEL | Two Years

COURSE OVERVIEW

Are you keen to understand how computing could change the world? If so, Computer Science is for you. It is all about designing new sets of algorithms to solve new problems. You will study programming and operating systems and conduct experiments to learn more about the natural world through software simulations.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

At least five GCSE passes, at grade 4 or above. In addition, students should meet the following minimum GCSE requirements, grade 6 in maths and grade 5 in English plus grade 6 in both Core and Additional Science, or grade 6 in Computer Science, if taken.

IT AND CREATIVE TECHNOLOGY

BTEC LEVEL 2 | One Year

COURSE OVERVIEW

On this course you will improve your knowledge of editing software, use digital communication technologies, create an animation, design and website and learn to code and more!

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

You will need a minimum of a grade 2 in GCSE English Language and maths. If you don't have a grade 4 in English and maths, you will be required to study for this alongside your course. Plus, you will need two additional GCSEs at grade 2 or above, or equivalent.

CYBERSECURITY

BTEC LEVEL 3 | Two Years

COURSE OVERVIEW

This is an exciting new course for those who would like to pursue a career in IT and cybersecurity. You will study a range of topics including: how devices communicate, designing and developing a simple computer network from a user specification, the identification and resolution of a range of threats and vulnerabilities.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

You will need four GCSEs at grade 9-4, including English and maths.

COMPUTER SCIENCE

BTEC LEVEL 3 | Two years

COURSE OVERVIEW

You will get to understand how computers work and gain practical experience in installing hardware and software. You will design, build and publish your own website and create animations using industry-standard software such as Adobe CS5. You will also develop programming skills using Visual Studio and develop your own games.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

You will need to have at least four GCSE passes at grade 4 or above. You should have basic IT skills and be interested in the practical aspects of computers, computer science and computer systems.

At least five GCSE passes, grade 4 or above. In addition, you should have a grade 5 in English Language.

BTEC MEDIA STUDIES, A LEVEL ART AND DESIGN (TEXTILES) A LEVEL AND MATHS GCSE

MEDIA STUDIES

A LEVEL | Two Years

COURSE OVERVIEW

This course will provide you with the opportunity to explore the world through important critical perspectives and take an increasingly analytical approach to media texts. You will also be able to apply your knowledge and understanding of the key concepts through the creation of your own media products. Topics include: Television in the Global Age, Changing Representations Media in the Digital Age, Video Games, Advertising and Music Video, News in the Online Age and Film Industries – from Wales to Hollywood.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

At least five GCSE passes grade 4 or above. In addition, you should have a grade 4 in English Language.

BTEC LEVEL 3 | Two Years

COURSE OVERVIEW

This course is for those wishing to focus their learning on creative digital media production, with a view to progressing to a related Higher Education course, and potentially a career in the creative industries. You will develop employability skills and knowledge through contextual projects, which build their communication skills and ability to work collaboratively, as well as developing practical skills in digital media hardware, software and processes.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

You will need to have at least four GCSE passes at grade 4 or above including English and maths.

CREATIVE DIGITAL MEDIA PRODUCTION

BTEC LEVEL 2 | One Year

COURSE OVERVIEW

This course provides you with the opportunity to explore, develop and test your creativity within media, developing your base of skills and knowledge, while enhancing your self-confidence and revealing the potential career demands and opportunities within the sector. You will cover topics including creative media methods and skills, audio and visual production and technology and a personal project and presentation in creative media production.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

You will need three Level 2 and two Level 3 grades at GCSE including English and maths minimum grade 2 or equivalent qualifications (a Pass or higher at BTEC Level 2 is accepted as part of the GCSE grades).

A LEVEL ENGLISH LITERATURE

A LEVEL | Two Years

COURSE OVERVIEW

This course combines a detailed study of literature with the opportunity to read more widely and independently. Throughout the course, you will be encouraged to attend theatre productions of the texts studied and to watch film versions of set and related texts. The course is divided into four components: drama, prose, poetry and coursework.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

At least 5 GCSE passes at grade 4 or above. In addition, grade 5 in English Language and grade 5 in English Literature (if taken).

A LEVEL ENGLISH LANGUAGE AND LITERATURE

A LEVEL | Two Years

COURSE OVERVIEW

If you enjoy English but feel that you can't choose between language (looking at a wide range of techniques and language in society) and literature (reading and commenting on written texts), this is the course for you. You'll focus on spoken language and language production as well as studying a wide range of literary texts – a chance to do both aspects of English in one A Level.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

At least 5 GCSE passes at grade 4 or above. In addition, grade 5 in English Language and grade 5 in English Literature (if taken).

ENGLISH LANGUAGE

GCSE

COURSE OVERVIEW

Students will study a wide range of texts from 19th, 20th and 21st centuries, including literature and literary non-fiction as well as other writing such as reviews and journalism. You will read and evaluate texts critically and make comparisons between texts, summarise and synthesise information or ideas from texts.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

This course is designed to cater for students who achieved a grade 3 and need to improve their grade to a grade 4.

BTEC LEVEL 3 | Two Years

COURSE OVERVIEW

This is an exciting course that gives students the opportunity to gain knowledge and understanding of the Health and Social Care sector. Topics include Human Lifespan Development, Working in Health and Social Care, Anatomy and Physiology, Enquires into Research and Public Health Infection Control and Hygiene. There will be 100 hours of compulsory work experience which will be incorporated into the course.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

At least four GCSE passes at grade 4 or above with English and maths at a minimum of grade 4. In addition, you should have a grade 4 in English Language. You will also need to have DBS check.

BTEC LEVEL 2 | One Year

COURSE OVERVIEW

This course gives students the opportunity to gain knowledge and understanding of Health and Social Care and to develop skills in the sector. It also gives students the potential opportunity to gain employment within the Health and Social Care sector. Successful completion of the course can lead to progression on to the BTEC Level 3 Health and Social Care course and/ or employment or an apprenticeship.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

You will require a minimum of three Level 2 and two Level 3 grades at GCSE.

HISTORY

A LEVEL | Two Years

COURSE OVERVIEW

This subject builds on the skills and knowledge you gained at school. In the first year you will look at Russia, 1917–1991 and China, 1949–1976. In the second year you will study a British History paper based on 'Protest, Agitation and Parliamentary Reform in Britain, c. 1780–1928' and a coursework assignment (Paper 4), worth 20% of the A Level marks. This requires students to write a 3,000-4,000 word assignment based on historian's interpretations of a historical controversy – Stalin's role in the purges.

COURSE OVERVIEW

This is a challenging and stimulating course that will encourage you to channel your creativity into individual creative investigations. Learn how to investigate and explore themes and ideas through the work of past and contemporary artists. You will develop your practical drawing skills together with painting, printmaking, 3D and more experimental work.

You will need at least five GCSE passes, grade 4 or above. You should also have a grade 4 in English, maths and Art or relevant Design Technology GCSE and grade 5 if taking two Art courses.

GRAPHIC DESIGN

A LEVEL | Two Years

COURSE OVERVIEW

Graphic Design is the communication of information and ideas by visual means. The critical elements for a graphic designer are the successful communication of a message through the organisation of words and images. This A Level is a largely practical course concerned with visual communication skills and will enable you to develop creative and innovative ways of expressing personal design concepts.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

You will need at least five GCSE passes, grade 4 or above. You should also have a grade 4 in English, maths and Art or relevant Design Technology GCSE and grade 5 if taking two Art courses.

PHOTOGRAPHY

A LEVEL | Two Years

COURSE OVERVIEW

You will learn the practical skills involved in processing and printing black and white film. The majority of images will be produced using a 35mm camera. A key component of the course will be the use of digital photography and processing. You will use Apple Macintosh digital imaging studio, using Adobe Photoshop and Illustrator software, to produce work that has a relevance to current design practice. The College studios are equipped with an impressive suite of computers, scanners and an A3 colour laser printer, with a large darkroom equipped with 16 enlargers.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

You will need at least five GCSE passes grade 4 or above. In addition, you should have a grade 4 in English, maths and Art or relevant Design Technology GCSE and grade 5 if taking two Art courses. If students only have a Merit for their BTEC Level 2, then a portfolio of work is also required. Students will need their own 35mm film SLR camera or a Digital SLR (DSLR) camera.

ART AND DESIGN

BTEC LEVEL 3 | One Year

COURSE OVERVIEW

This course will equip you with in-depth knowledge into a wide selection of areas within the creative fields of Fine Art, Design and Textiles. The course structure can allow the qualification to be flexible to meet your interests, abilities and aspirations. The College runs a number of educational experiences each year to enable students to contextualise their learning. These experiences include trips to galleries, outdoor drawing opportunities and photoshoots, external competitions, participation in a local craft fair and talks by visiting speakers, including a variety of local designers and artists.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

You will need to have at least four GCSE passes at grade 4 or above. You should also have GCSE grade 4 in Art or relevant Design Technology OR Merit in BTEC Level 2 Art and Design plus a suitable portfolio.
