We welcomed artist Rachel Gadsden for a special workshop with our Art and Design students in partnership with Your Croydon and the National Gallery.

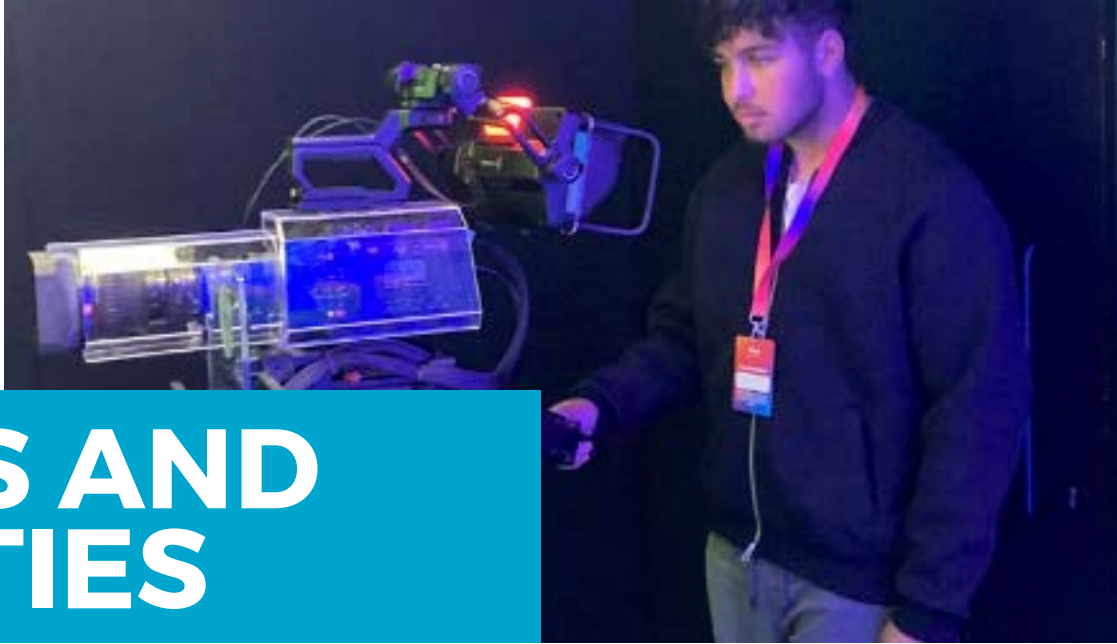
Rachel led students through creative activities linked to the artwork chosen for our display arriving soon. To view the full video go to our **Coulsdon Sixth Form College** Instagram page.

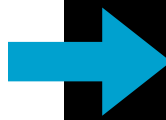

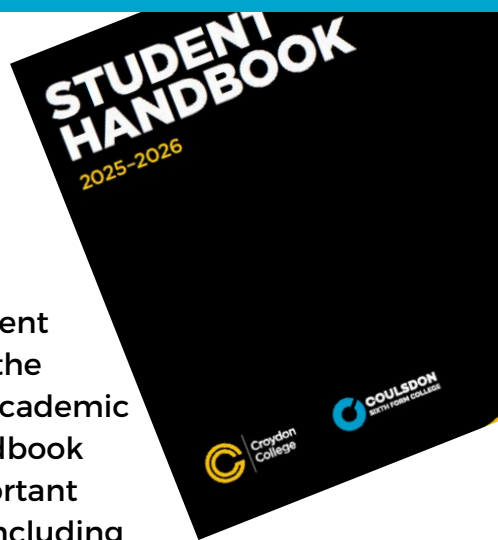
